



F. 8. 1. Maintenance Services School Nutrition

Background and Rationale

Division of Facilities and Operations

A competitive solicitation process was completed for the School Nutrition Program to provide inspection and maintenance services for kitchen hood suppression systems and fire extinguishers. Invitation to Bid #26-002 was emailed to six vendors and posted to the Muscookee County School District (MCSD) website on August 14, 2025. The Purchasing Department received proposals from three vendors:

- ACom Integrated Solutions
- Columbus Fire & Safety
- Fuller Fire & Safety

All responses were re-evaluated to ensure accuracy and fairness in the bid process. After re-evaluating all responses, it was determined that Fuller Fire & Safety offered the lowest price, inclusive of all required services. The Board is asked to approve the contract award to Fuller Fire & Safety for the inspection and maintenance of kitchen hood suppression systems and fire extinguishers. This contract will be effective from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026.
